❖ **Veni Harlan** - "Glory" Nonsuch Morning Glory CGC, hasn't been out much this year but she did pick up her first two points, 4 reserves (2 of which were major reserves), and a Group 1 Adult Match. We've also done a bit of practice coursing. That was going well until she discovered the lure was plastic and not at all like the squirrels that inspire extreme acceleration at home! Glory is one of those "too smart for her own britches" bitches. "Mardi" Cornerstone's Mardi Gras, my first Cardigan Welsh Corgi, has fit in quite well here with the "big" dogs. At first, the Borzoi didn't know what to make of her but very quickly fell in love. Except for Queen Storm who simply pretends Mardi is invisible. Mardi has no fear and loads of charm. She races hard with Glory and hangs on to those long Borzoi tails sliding like a skier on a smooth lake. It's hysterical to see such opposites playing together. Mardi's gotten around making something of a name for herself.:>) She earned a match group 1 at her very first show; her photographs have been used on promotional materials for a New Jersey dog parade and at the California Eukanuba National dog show "Meet the Breeds" booth; and she was asked to be the Louisiana Coursing Trials mascot due to her performance on the lure where she outshone several sighthounds! who knew? I just put up my first solo photography show and no one was surprised to find a few canines among in the exhibit...:>) Two of my "Borzoi" photos were accepted earlier this year to the "Art Show at the Dog Show", an annual juried show held in conjunction with the Sunflower cluster in Wichita, Kansas. We took Campari to Tennessee where he finished his championship by winning his last major at the Memphis Afghan Hound Club Specialty. So, he is now officially Champion Elite Lagniappe Campario, aka Champion Brat. Since Cinderella was along for the ride to Memphis, we decided she could take a turn around the Borzoi ring. She came home with back-to-back BoB's."

❖ **Sherry Faye Rodarmor** - "Shefaro Borzoi finished out the year with ten champions, including, but not limited to: International (FCI), American, Mexican and Guatemalan Champion Shefaro Amadeo's Rodrigo, American Champion Shefaro's Chevalier Rouge, Mexican Champion Shefaro's Honore, International (USA) Champion Shefaro Isabella's Pegaso, International (USA) Champion Shefaro Kyrie's Lorelei, and International (USA) Champion Fabiana's Rolando. International (USA) and American High In Trial Champion Shefaro Alejandro's

Allegra, JC, CD, CDX, UD, finished her Utility Dog title with a score of 186-1/2 and high hound in trial. Congratulations to owners/friends who made this possible. I wish everyone a very happy holiday season and happy new year."

❖ **Kitty and Jimmy Sawyer** - "Jamie/Virago babies are 5 weeks now. All 10 are fat and sassy just like their mom. Nothing but little food processors. Born 11-4-03 on Jamie's 4th birthday. Brother Blue is still at camp. He will be spending the month of December learning what the lure course is about. So far he is having great fun but we miss him terribly. We look forward to all the visitors we will be having over the holidays to see pups. Happy Holidays!"

❖ **Lynn Shell and Victor Whitlock** - "We seemed to have spent more time at performance events this last quarter than showing. Flareon picked up more NGRC points and Perci earned more GRC points at the September LGRA meet. Sassi won the NOTRA meet, with Monkee and Kalipso also earning ORC points. Sassi had several ASFA breed wins with large entries, and Rocki is over halfway to completing his ASFA FC and has all of his needed placements. Flareon and Monkee have had several placements in the FC stake. Kalipso earned his ASFA field championship in 5 straight trials, beginning with the LSBC's first official trial in October. Hehas also started on his AKC FC and earned a Best in Field at his 2nd AKC trial! In the ring, Rocki has picked up 6 points including a major, taking Winners at Travis County and at Cen-Tex. Burni took a trip with Jill to Monterrey and returned a Mexican champion. On a sadder note, we had to say goodbye to Freddi in late November after a long illness. He was my first homebred champion and is dearly missed."

❖ **Richard Terry and Rita Linck** - "Richard Mason Terry and Rita Linck's girl from the first Aria litter - Latina (Aria's Carpe Diem), went WB/BOW/BOB at the Belton shows for her first major at the tender age of 6 months and 4 days. In her very first Hound Group, Latina made the cut, then walked without a placement in the company of a multi-BIS whippet - very tough competition. She and her brother, Aria's Cry Havoc have several major reserves since then, and Latina earned an additional two singles at the Mesquite shows. At his first show - Cypress Creek Kennel Club, Jesse (Kirov's Desperado at Aria) went WD/BOW for a major under breeder judge Jan Leikam. On the weekend of September 27-28, 2003, Diva (Cameo's Ice Dreams) and Madeline (Sunburst Madeline of Nobility) attended their first LGRA meet. On Saturday, Madeline placed third (of 17) behind the #1 and #2 ranked borzoi, earning 4 points towards her Gazehound Racing Championship. On Sunday, Madeline and Diva were in a three-way tie for third (of 18) and each earned 3.167 points At GIT's LGRA meets on November 1-2, Diva earned an additional 2.5 points towards her GRC, and Maddie an additional 1.5. In ASFA coursing this fall, Diva earned 98 points and all placements towards her FCh, and Maddie lacks only a first placement for her FCh. In AKC coursing this fall, Maddie has earned 4 points and Diva 3 points towards their AKC FC's."

❖ **Sara Whittington and Wayne Rowe** - Flare finished his championship at the Houston shows in early November. He was pointed completely from the Bred-By classes and is the 5th of his litter to finish. Fancy earned her first points by taking Winner's Bitch both days at the Conroe shows.
