BRAGGING RIGHTS

Don't forget to send your news to me! I've known of some spectacular brags that never got reported - so please send them in to share with the club!

❖ Ed and Linda Bourne - Phillip is now formally known as Ch. Zabava Milky Way JC CGC, earning 2 majors in San Antonio and a major in Houston, back-to-back weekends. He finished owner-handled by Linda. He earned his CGC in Jackson, MS six weeks later. He will be specialied in 2005.

❖ Dee and Greg Jones - "We haven't been out on the show circuit since June. However, right now we are looking forward to Lagniappe Hounds' first litter. Our Silken Windhound princess Punzi (Kristull Lagniappe Rapunzel) was bred to Int. Am. Can. Ch. Kristull Dante by Cool Run (owned by Gloria Hyland-Fisher, Cool Run Hounds). For those who don't know, Silken can be shown at Rarities, Inc. shows, where Dante earned his dual championships. Puppies are due in early November. Greg has been busy helping Baton Rouge Parks and CAAWS (a local animal welfare society) organize a Halloween Pets and Pals event for October 24. There will be lots of dog-based events and lure coursing if anyone wants to come practice."

❖ Sherry Rodarmor - "The first son of my Swedish import, Ch. Zchatsaj's Shefaro Guillermo, finished his American championship in grand style by winning Best of Breed over specials. The next day as a move-up, Aries won Best of Breed over specials and took a Hound Group Third. Congratulations to owner Carol Olson and her first Borzoi Champion Shefaro's Aries who finished at 17 months of age."

❖ Joe Rogers- "I would like to tell you a little about my three puppies that I have now had for about 5 months. I got my two puppy bitches from Dr. Suzanne Newsom of Georgia in early May. They are: Top Flight Dream Kiss O Th'Czar (Kissee) and Top Flight Dream Angel (better known as Gabriel or Gabe); these litter sisters are now 8 months old. The breeding is: Ch. Khanzade's Winter Intrigue X. Ch. Top Flight Unattenuated. This is a line breeding on Katie Averill's kennel lines. My puppy dog is from Nadine Johnson, and I got him in late May. His breeding is: Ch. Rising Star Conquistador X Ch. Octavia de Nikolaiev (Nadine's French import). His AKC name is Rising Star DP Phantom, with a call name of Phantom and is now 7 months old. I also sometimes call him Pigpen, after the cartoon character in Peanuts, because if there is any mud or water and dirt anywhere, he will play in it or dive in it. He also has the biggest "grin" I've ever seen on a Borzoi and also, is one of the most mischievous, loving dogs. All the puppies have really great personalities, outstanding temperament and, even at this age, are starting to really blossom. The three puppies made their show debut at the Texas Kennel Club show in Fort Worth in September. We hope to see you all in the ring in the upcoming months and at the National Specialty in Mesquite in April. Good showing to all of you."

❖ Kitty and Jimmy Sawyer - "We have a litter planned with Blue (Ch. Katz Bayou Blue Haze) and Chant (Ch. Teine Enchantress)! One of our Jamie/Virago daughters got a major on her first weekend to show in Monroe, LA. That was exciting and pretty big news!"

❖ Sandy Simmons - "Wilbur took back-to-back Group Placements, a Two and a Three, at the Greater Humble Area KC dog shows. Chalice also picked up another point and a Best of Winners."

❖ Susan Van de Water - "As of August 20, Spitzer (Del Sol Spitzer, JC LCM2 GRC) was #1 in ASFA lure coursing; Danceman (Del Sol Lord of the Dance, JC FCh) was #5; Belle Starr (Ch. Del Sol Belle Starr, JC LCM GRC) #12; and Inferno (Kyrov's Inferno Del Sol, FCh) #14. Sheena (FC Del Sol High Velocity, FCh), owned by Mary Childs, is ranked #18 in ASFA after only running a few times this year. She is Spitzer's sister."

❖ R. Lynn Shell-Whitlock and Victor Whitlock - "Duri (Ch. Gryffyn's Aeyrie Anduril) was awarded two Best of Breeds at the River Cluster shows in July. Her recognition at such a highly attended show with intense competition was very exciting! Rocki (Ch. Chataqua Sensation at Gryffyn's Aeyrie, JC) finished his ASFA Field Championship at the ICGA lure trials in early October - a great way to start up the running season! The next day when moved up to the FCh stake, he placed 3rd behind the top 2 dogs in the country, a placement that had been taken by Magik (Chataqua Gryffyns La Magie Continue, JC FCh) the day before. We are also happy to announce that we have two newly arrived litters of bouncing baby Borzois! Solo (Gryffyn's It's All About Me) arrived on August 12, a son of Kalipso (BIF DC Rising Star Kalipso, SC FCh) and Doodle (Ch. Promise Gryffyn's Spyrograph, SC JOR GRC). After discovering that Doodle would only be presenting us with a singleton, we also bred Miss T (DC Nickolai Misty Clairidge, SC JOR SGRC FCh) to Arthur (Ch. Gryffyns Once N Future King, SGRC), and she whelped 7 beautiful babies on September 30. As to non-Borzoi news - we were thrilled to have our home-bred Silken Windhound, Tyler (Rarities Ch. Gryffyn's Just Push Play) awarded a Best in Show at the Denver Rarities show! His mother Josi (Rarities Ch. Kristull Jumpin Jehosephat) was awarded a Reserve Best in Show at the same cluster.
