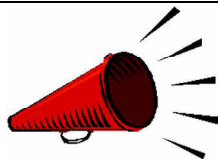

We also competed in the ASFA Region 4 Invitationals on December 4th, where Sara turned in three very impressive runs to win BOB and receive the Ravenwolf Perpetual Trophy. And then to top it all off, on December 19th, Mir was first at the NOTRA event hosted at Windyglen, to complete his ORC title! ## **Bowser Biscuits**

1 cup chicken broth  
2/3 cup margarine, softened  
1 cup powdered milk  
2 t. salt  
2 eggs, beaten  
1 cup pureed liver (chicken or beef)  
1 envelope dry onion mix  
2 t. garlic powder  
6 cups whole wheat flour

In a large bowl pour heated chicken broth over margarine, mix until margarine is melted. Add the powdered milk, salt, liver, onion soup mix, and garlic powder; stir. Add eggs, mix well. Gradually add in flour, and knead well. Roll out to 1/2 inch thickness; cut into bone shapes or 1" x 4" bars. Place on greased cookie sheet and cook at 350 degrees for 50 minutes. Allow to cool completely. These will be quite hard when cooked. Makes around 3 pounds of biscuits. You can make smaller sizes for little dogs but you will need to reduce cooking time by 5-10 minutes so they won't burn.
